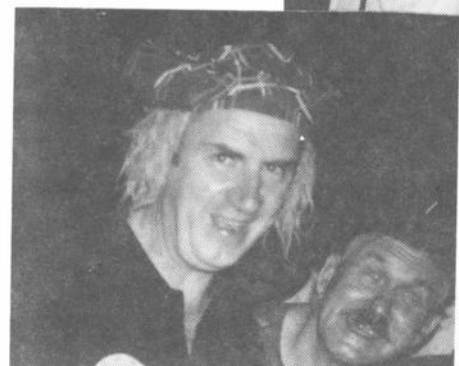

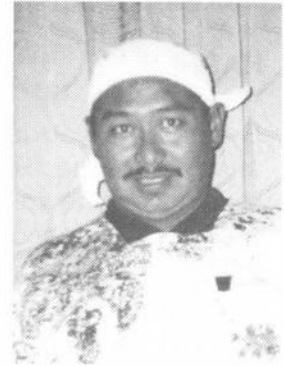


Dave Findlay (Hard Case) Runs - no, not "the runs"

To all Pan-Asia Hash participants,

Batavia Hash House Harrier Hoons welcomes all you hashers from near, far and very far. Some of you we know as old friends. Others will be visiting Jakarta for the first time and may be so ignorant as not to know that Batavia is the old name for Jakarta: so old that only a few, like Browneye, remember those good old days.

Today much has changed. Gone from the main streets are the becaks (pedicabs) and horse-drawn carts except on Sundays around Senayan; the stadium at Senayan was built to host an Olympic games which the Olympic Committee in their wisdom decided should not be held here. However some of the old is left and some of the new is right.

Browneye is still here, although how much is not past its use-by date is debatable. The Club remains a haven for hashers albeit in a new location and with its Indonesianised name "Klub". Still hanging out there are most of the original maidens, now with their daughters, while their granddaughters ply their inherited trade in newer, flashier dives such as Oscars (sorry, "Oskars"). The wooden Pinisi sailing ships still crowd the port of Sunda Kelapa having dodged the container ships that now dominate the waters of the Bay of Jakarta. The main thoroughfares of the city are now flanked by towerblocks which remain largely empty because the workers are stuck in the traffic jams caused by drivers seeking non-existent car parks. The old street markets have gone, replaced by department stores containing expensive luxuries that only Arabs can afford. A new airport has opened, but they keep the original one operational for the older Garuda pilots that forget and are too deaf to hear the air traffic controllers. The sun still sets every evening like a fireball, but visible now only from 100 kms beyond Jakarta's borders because of the city's pollution. Every house now has its TV and parabola but the newspapers arrive too late to misinform readers of the previous days programmes.

But you don't need to know all this, you won't have time this weekend to enjoy the real Jakarta experience. Most of your time will be spent in buses taking you to the runs, in buses bringing you back from the runs or standing beside the buses waiting to leave. In the little time remaining you will be either drinking, running, drinking, eating, drinking, looking for a pharmacy which is (a) open and (b) sells Anadin and Streptomycin or drinking. The farsighted few, those that planned to get here early and were fortunate enough to arrive on-time with hash gear that was not put on the plane to Rio de Janeiro, will be able to take in the highlight of the Jakarta week - namely the Batavia H4 run, Thursday evening. Hope you do, see you then or during the weekend.

HOW IT ALL BEGAN

Well, I woke up one morning and there was this awful rash on my ..

There were these drunken squaddies in Malaysia years ago and they told their wives they had been out running among rubber trees following a trail of shredded paper, and their wives believed them.

Hashing in Jakarta started in March 1971 when the Jakarta Hash House Harriers was formed at a time when only 10 other hash chapters existed worldwide. The driving force was an ex-patriate named Jeremy Pidgeon who worked for a foreign trading company and who had hashed in Malaysia. Other founder members include Gordon ("Bendover") Benton, an Architect who is still here in Jakarta and currently technical adviser to the Lippo Village development in Karawaci and can on occasions be seen wheezing singing in the circle on a Monday night.

In 1975 the Jakarta Hash House Harriets was formed from a ~~uterus~~-nucleus of ladies who had previously run with the Jakarta Hash. This hash has flourished since its formation and runs on Wednesday nights (starts same time as Mondays - 1700hrs)

While interest in Hashing has fluctuated over the years it reached its peak in Jakarta in 1982 when the two hash chapters hosted the 3rd International Gathering (Interhash) of some 2000 hashers, at that time the regular membership exceeded 300 regular runners.

In 1988 the Batavia Hash House Harrier Hoons was formed and so offered runners a third weekly (Thursday) evening venue when they could run. Four years later, due to the demand for a mixed sex hash the T.G.I.F (no, not toes go in first!) was formed late 1989. Both these Hashes start also at 1700hrs

Most recently two new hash chapters have emerged. The Surabaya ex- Hash House Harriers and the Java Hash House Horrors have been formed, the latter being for parents and children and whose monthly runs attract a lot of flies a regular gathering of between 80 and 100 hashers.

On behalf of all hash chapters we welcome you to Pan Asia Jakarta 97 and hope you can stay sober long enough to sample as many of the Hash chapters as possible.

SOME REMINISCENCES OF HASHING, JAKARTA

I have been asked Browneye for some recollections of my time with Jakarta Hash, which was 1978-80 or from Run Number 404 on 18 September 1978. I haven't completed my last run with JH3 just yet so I can't give you my final run.

The committee (1978-1979) was led by John W.D. "Willie Dick" Humphries, YW Joints were Ross Singer and Peter Wotton, Jacques de Steur was Music master. Our Godfather, bless his cotton socks, was the peerless and sadly now departed Jeremy Pidgeon. In those days we even had a Hash Pussy, and Aussie, Carol Cooney.

Outstation runs were held at places like Samudra and Carita Beaches or up in the Puncak. Stir Sticque used to mismanage Auto Hashes and we would all drive around in Jakarta traffic trying to knock more Becaks into the next millennium than Jacques could.

We drank at places like the Tanamor and Tankard and after the Circle adjourn to Restaurant 99 on Jl. Fatmawati for Dogshit Goring and a food fight. Sometimes the overhead fans could blow the Nasty Goring and Fishheads out onto the street. One night we spotted the resident rat using the top of the dividing wall as a race track. Immediately the evening's makan was heaved at the tikus besar who beat a hasty and unharmed retreat over the wall into the shop next door. The owner reassured the Hash Pack by telling us "tidak apa apa." The tikus is not mine, it belongs in next door!

The Hash Thrash was held at ISCI and was usually the best (mixed) night of the year. Ross "Opera" Singer mismanaged the raffle in 1978 and won first prize, which was presented by the Jakarta Harriets; and included the "works" at the Gemini Bar, also known as the Black Hole.

Ronnie Strachan had black hair then and Len "Baltimore" Funk introduced "The Girl From Baltimore" to the hash Circle for the first time this year. At the Highland Gathering, Willie Dick managed to do himself a serious injury when he took to tugging rope instead of tugging the usual.

Gordon Benton (ex Run No. 1) was awarded "The Hashit of The Year" at Run 399 on the 21st August. His name was added to a Hashit Board which then only included 3 rows of plaques.

What really set the Jakarta Hash apart in the late 1970s was the quality of the respect accorded the GM, RA and MoM in the Circle. Consequently the Jakarta Hash Circles were the best in all of Hashdom at that time. They lasted until all hours of the night, rain, hail or moonshine. Pushing bogged cars out of Pondok Cabe at 10.00 pm was not a novelty, and that was before the Restoran Tikus Besar. The singing was superb and I think the most exotic song was "Irian Jaya". John Carter "The Farther", was also resplendent in black hair, on top of his head, as well as on his face and only weighed about 30% of his present bulk. His repertoire extended beyond the Vatican Rag, but not his ability to hold a tune.

1978 was also the year that I first saw ice being used. I also suspect that 1978 may have seen the debut of "The Big One". At least in my memory, Andy Pandy Hardiman was the first one to sink a mug "that" size (2 litres).

However, notwithstanding the above, Stuart Murray was the best drinker of Down Downs bar none. Stuart, (a Kiwi), would do Down Downs from a bucket. Drink it all down with minimal spillage, hold it down for a few seconds and then in a display of the fastest moving Anker in town he would throw it all back up again. Upon its return the Anker was still cold enough to drink!!

By 1979, Jakarta was hosting an average attendance of 120 each Monday evening at Jam Lima sore. Jacques de Steur was by now the GM.

The Hash darts team performed above expectations that year. It managed to attend each game with a full complement. Sadly in the final they were beaten by a ladies team, The Jakarta Hash House Harriettes!

Significant leavers of the year included "The Burung", Jeremy Pidgeon. He had been Hashing Jakarta since Run No. 1 and completed almost 350 of the 475 runs since 1971. What a performance on his last night! he drank 7, count em, 7 down downs, and throughout it all he kept his pipe burning.

The Royal navy visited Jakarta that year and lemming like they were led to the hash. Andy Hardiman, who had spent the weekend exchanging rugby niceties with the RNers, was their Hashost. Little were they to know upon their arrival that Andy was the RA! By the time they left they knew what his role at the hash was, although whether they could remember that role is a moot point.

Finally it all had to end and I was forced to leave by an expired contract.

It is impossible to encapsulate those 2 years in these few words. I remember Puncak runs, beachside runs; I remember the 500th run, what a blast. I remember Interhash in KL with the Jakarta HHH pack. I remember running in places like Blok M and Kebayorans Lama and Baru. Off Fatmawati was a favorite, as was Country Woods, ISCI and Pondok Cabe. Just about impossible to run there now.

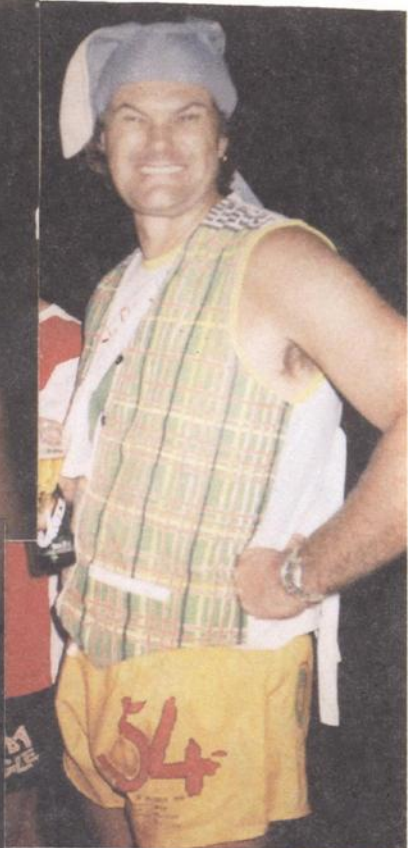
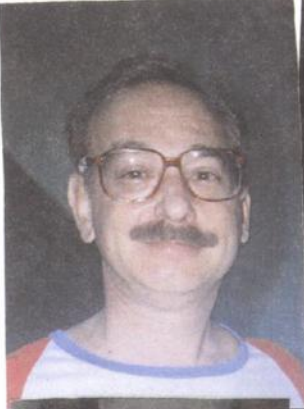
